

THE 3 PILLARS OF OUR MISSION



HEALING TOUCH FOR INTEGRATIVE CANCER CARE

Offering Healing Touch (HT) to Cancer Patients and their Caregivers: We believe wholeheartedly in the efficacy of Healing Touch when used with traditional cancer care. Research continues to show just how powerful the mind body connection is and that integrative therapies like Healing Touch can make a positive difference in a person's healing. We are committed to providing sessions, knowing they help our participants manage the side effects of radiation and chemotherapy, such as fatigue, anxiety, loss of appetite, pain and lymphedema. In evaluations, an overwhelming number of our participants report receiving significant benefits from their sessions.

TRAINING AND SUPPORTING PROVIDERS

Training and Supporting our Healing Touch Providers: We are able to offer our Healing Touch sessions because of our heart-centered Providers who are deeply dedicated to the work, and we find it vital to offer them ongoing support and training. All our Providers must complete HT classes of level 2 or above, along with an in-depth training covering the medical, emotional, energetic, professional and ethical aspects of working with our Participants. Our Providers are our biggest asset, so we offer monthly meetings, resources and online community connection to foster their self-care and personal development. Equal opportunities are vital to a diverse and thriving community: we dedicate a portion of our funding to scholarships for HT classes and highly encourage our underserved community members to apply.



AWARENESS AND PARTNERSHIPS

Expanding Healing Touch into new Healthcare Settings: Increasing access to Healing Touch is one of our top priorities! By educating and collaborating with our community's medical professionals, we can help facilitate an integrative healthcare approach. Elke Wehner, an HPCC volunteer Provider, spearheaded our latest endeavor within CHOMP, a local hospital. Elke led a campaign that encouraged nurses to learn about Healing Touch and worked with different departments to incorporate the therapy into the hospital. Volunteer Providers offered Healthcare workers at all levels sessions to experience firsthand the benefits of Healing Touch, which can transform patient care and also serve as a powerful self-care tool. We see this as a win, win opportunity!

FROM WHENCE WE CAME

FROM STANFORD HEALTH CARE ...

Healing Partners began at Stanford in 2004 with a three year research grant from the Avon Foundation to study the benefits of Healing Touch for breast cancer patients undergoing medical treatment. With data confirming positive benefits, the program expanded from research to providing this service more broadly. Clinical settings for this work sprang up throughout the Bay Area as more Healing Touch providers joined the team and requests for service spread throughout the region. Additionally, this



service expanded to serve all kinds of cancer patients, not only breast cancer. The service continues to include weekly Healing Touch sessions, offered free to recipients, by an expanding team of Healing Touch providers.

... TO THE CENTRAL COAST

With encouragement from Stanford in 2010, Margot Baker (one of the early Stanford team of providers) brought this program to the Monterey Peninsula. By 2015, our local team included 5 providers; by 2017, we had expanded to 15! While word of mouth referrals sparked early requests for our service, we expanded rapidly when local oncologists began promoting this option to their patients. Pacific Cancer Care is now one of our primary sites for service.

Between 2017 and 2020, we served approximately 100 local cancer patients yearly, each receiving 8-12 free weekly sessions while undergoing treatment. This rapid expansion led to our



need for more local leadership and resources. In 2019 we started the process to become our own 501(c)(3), Healing Partners Of The Central Coast. By May, 2020, we had launched! Our dedicated team remains committed to provide our sessions at no cost to these cancer patients, and now also their caregivers and healthcare workers. We now have a number of local service sites and hope to expand more as we emerge from the pandemic constraints.

WHAT A GIFT IT WAS FOR ME



BERKANA ALBRECHT'S STORY

Diagnosed with cancer in 2018, I pretty much fell apart. I didn't want to die, but that was the outcome I was expecting since I had lost friends to cancer. After a hysterectomy I was told I needed chemotherapy and radiation and would most likely go bald. I cried a lot. With my wife by my side I went to Pacific Cancer Care to start my treatments. I was shaking so bad that my wife had to fill out the paperwork. Dr. Nancy Rubin was my

oncologist. When she walked into the room I started crying and felt so much fear. Her kindness and explanations put me at peace and my treatments got started.

There's a lot of emotion that comes up during cancer treatments. The most impactful came after washing my hair. Even forewarned, one is never fully prepared for seeing hands full of fallen out hair. It sent my emotions spiraling. Shortly thereafter, Dr. Rubin suggested Healing Touch (HT).



She said it was an energy therapy. I didn't know what that meant, but it was free and I was open to trying everything.

I called the Program Coordinator and was assigned a Provider who was very friendly and made me comfortable. We were to meet once a week at the same day and time each week for seven weeks.

At my first session my Provider asked a lot of questions about my physical, emotional, mental and spiritual well being. I felt her compassion but I

didn't know what I would experience. I had no idea how powerful it would be. Energy was going through my body, clearing my mind of fogginess and fear. It relieved pain and opened my

heart and emotions. There were times I felt amazing energy and times I cried. But I felt safe no matter what I was experiencing. Every session was different but I felt so at peace after each one. I had thought that I needed to be so strong going through my treatments, but my HT sessions taught me that it was okay to just be vulnerable. The sessions were so powerful I continued private sessions.

I never thought about becoming a student but I felt so much gratitude I wanted to be able to give back to others what was given to me. I took my first HT class and what a beautiful experience it was. HT healed me physically but also opened up my heart and soul to go deeper spiritually. The healing that opened up for me is a continuous journey. I'm very grateful for my Provider's gentle work and for those I've met through this program. What a gift it was for me.

Diane Dobronte & Margot Baker — Champions of Participants Served


During the course of a year, HPCC Providers serve many clients. Going way beyond the norm, however, are providers Diane Dobronte and Margot Baker. Because they are both 100% dedicated to the well-being of their clients, they never say, "I'm at my limit." In 2020, this translated into 111 Healing Partners

sessions for Diane and 84 for Margot. Please keep in mind that this is just a fraction of the total sessions each of them has offered to other friends and family during this same year. These two healers inspire us, because they have touched countless lives both directly and indirectly, with their skill and compassion. OUR IMPACTFUL VOLUNTEERS

ABOUT THE SESSIONS

Our highly trained Providers connect standard medical care and complementary medicine. Their goal is to promote wellbeing by working with vital energy flows that sustain the health and well-being of our Participants. Using gentle touch, Providers restore balance to the energy flow to support the body's own natural healing. Sessions last 45-60 minutes. Providers often work with more than one client at a time.



TRAINING AND STEPPING IN WHERE NEEDED

Who knew that going to a staff meeting could be the highlight of the month? Well, that's our norm at HPCC meetings as we join together in curiosity, awe and comradery two times a month. Not only do we learn from each other, but we also get insights from medical, scientific and energy experts from all over the country. Our volunteers have also freely and willingly stepped

in to help HPCC get organized and set systems in place prior to having staff available to handle these varied and sundry tasks. We wouldn't be where we are without their help and dedication.


TOTAL SESSIONS PAID FOR BY PARTICIPANTS

EMBRACING CHANGE DURING COVID

- Creating a safe way to continue providing sessions to our cancer patients
- Expanding services to Caregivers and front-line Healthcare Workers
- Committing to keep our services free for our Participants.

REMOTE SESSIONS: A SAFE AND CONVENIENT ALTERNATIVE



Prior to COVID, we always offered our Healing Touch sessions in person. As the pandemic developed, we quickly realized that ensuring the safety of our Participants and Providers would necessitate changing our treatment protocol. We had always used Remote Healing Touch; we just began offering it exclusively in order to provide the same support to our cancer patients from the safety and comfort of their own homes.

WE ARE HONORED TO SUPPORT YOU CAREGIVERS!

In our work with Cancer Patients we also see the loving Caregivers by their side. Caring for someone who is sick, taking on new responsibilities, and worrying about the future can cause extra stress and anxiety. We had always wanted to offer Healing Touch to Caregivers so when the pandemic imposed isolation, we knew there was no better time to start. Caregivers have enthusiastically received this initiative! Caregiver fatigue is real, and we



are so excited to offer this new support to meet the need!



THANK YOU, HEALTHCARE WORKERS!

We know of the added stress and anxiety our Healthcare Workers face during these times, and we choose to support and uplift them! We felt a need to recognize and thank our courageous Healthcare Workers for all they do to keep us safe during the pandemic. Knowing our service would also be immensely beneficial for those on the front-line in the healthcare arena, we reached out to several local hospitals and other healthcare organizations to offer Healing Touch to their stressed and overworked staff members. The feedback has been overwhelmingly positive!

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

CURRENT TRENDS — We see America's top hospitals like Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, Stanford Healthcare, the Mayo Clinic, the Duke University Medical Center and the Yale New Haven Hospital embracing integrative therapies like Healing Touch. Why? Because they work! Integrative care research shows it to be more effective and less expensive than standard medical care alone. We are dedicated to aligning with the trends to create opportunities for whole person care in our community.



EXPANSION OF TREATMENT SITES — We want to create more access to our services for underserved parts of our community, including Salinas and Seaside and are excited to branch out into these areas. We will do this by actively seeking additional partner locations where we can offer our free services.

RECRUITMENT OF PROVIDERS — To increase services, we need to recruit and train additional Providers. The pandemic has slowed the training process but not the enthusiasm and excitement for joining our team. As we see COVID cases decline and an easing to restrictions, we eagerly look forward to returning to our training classes and adding to our volunteer Provider family.
